

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Did You Know?

7 of the Largest Landfills in the World

- 1. Great Pacific Garbage Patch, Pacific Ocean: approximately the size of Texas
- 2. Bordo Poniente Landfill, Nezahualcoyotl, Mexico: receives 12K tons/day
- 3. Fresh Kills Landfill, New York: once the world's largest man-made structure; 150M tons
- **4.** Lagos Dump, Nigeria: 500 container ships arrive each month, delivering 10K tons/day
- **5.** Apex Regional Landfill, Las Vegas, NV: holds 50M tons; receives 9K tons/day; has over 1B tons capacity
- 6. Sudokwon Landfill, South Korea: holds 88M tons; receives 6K tons/day
- 7. **Puente Hills Landfill, Los Angeles, CA:** covers over 700 acres; almost 500' high; holds almost 4M tons; takes in 12K tons/day



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Trump's First 50 Days

The following is a breakdown of Trumps performance in the first 50 days he was President of the USA, by the numbers:

- 90+ = Rules and regulations overturned.
- **265** = Number of tweets from January 20 to March 10.
- 16 = Number of executive orders signed as of March 6.
- 4 = Number of cabinet-level nominees not yet confirmed.
- **235,000** = Number of jobs gained in February. Employment gains occurred in construction, private educational services, manufacturing, health care, and mining.
- **36** (at least) = Number of lobbyists hired.
- 41% = Gallup approval rating as of March 8, down 4 points from January 22.
- 5.3 = Number of tweets per day.
- **20** = Number of times Trump called out "fake news" on Twitter.
- **40**% = Percentage of presidential trips that have been to Mar-a-Lago.
- \$7.5 million = Estimated cost of security at Trump Tower since the inauguration.
- **36** = Number of drone strikes.
- **8** = Number of times he's played golf.
- **20,860** = Dow Jones Industrial Average on March 9, up 1,033 points since January 20.
- 36% = Drop in daily rate of undocumented immigrants caught crossing the Mexican border (comparing February to January).
