

THE 2017 ECLIPSE ACROSS AMERICA

On Monday, August 21, 2017, all of North America will be treated to an eclipse of the sun. Anyone within the path of totality can see one of nature's most awe inspiring sights - a total solar eclipse. This path, where the moon will completely cover the sun and the sun's tenuous atmosphere - the corona - can be seen, will stretch from Salem, Oregon to Charleston, South Carolina.

Observers outside this path will still see a partial solar eclipse where the moon covers part of the sun's disk. At our offices in Santa Rosa, CA, the eclipse will be seen at 80% at 10:15 am (PDT).

Did You Know?

All human eyes are brown. The amount of the pigment melanin, which is brown, in the iris reflects certain wavelengths of light outward, giving the appearance of a different color. The more melanin, the more light that is absorbed and the browner the eyes appear. The less melanin, the more light that is reflected, giving the appearance of hazel, green, or blue eyes.










England vs Great Britain vs United Kingdom Explained

Is England Britain? Is Britain England? Where does Ireland fit in? Then what is Northern Ireland? And what about Scotland? Then what exactly is the UK (United Kingdom)? And what about the British Isles?

The following map explains the complicated relationships and names that people often, mistakenly, use interchangeably:



British Isles: consists of the islands of Great Britain, Ireland, and over six thousand smaller isles (including: the Bailiwicks of Jersey and Guernsey and the Isle of Man).

Great Britain: the larger of the 2 main islands consists of Scotland, England, and Wales.

Ireland: the smaller of the 2 main islands consist of the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland.

United Kingdom: The United Kingdom is a fully independent sovereign state made up of the the 3 countries on Great Britain plus Northern Ireland, which is reflected in its full name: United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

Now for the fun bit: Everyone from England, Scotland and Wales is also British, but not people from Northern Ireland who are Irish (despite also being UK citizens). People from the Republic of Ireland are just Irish. And, none of these groups, except for people from England, should be referred to as English.

So if you're Scottish, you're British; and if you're English, you're British; and if you're Welsh, you are also British. But Scottish are not English and English are not Scottish and Welsh are not English. And Irish are not British; they're just Irish. And only Northern Ireland is part of the United Kingdom. And all of them are from the British Isles... but that doesn't make them all British. Get it?
